

January 20, 2019: Announcement from the Search Committee about the parish forums

*PARISH-WIDE FORUMS—Mark your calendars now!* The Search Committee will be hosting two Parish-wide forums in February. The purpose of these discussions will be to present an overview of the responses to the Parish Questionnaire, to update the Parish on the search process, and to allow members of the Parish to share their thoughts with members of the Search Committee as they work on preparing the Parish Profile. The forums will be moderated by Lynda Blair, chair of the Search Committee, together with other members of the committee. The forums will be held on *Sunday, February 10, 2019 after the 9 o'clock Mass* (with Lynda Blair, Meg Nelson, and Jack Gurnon moderating) and on *Sunday, February 17, 2019 after the 11:15 Mass* (with Lynda Blair and John Boyd moderating).

We will hold the meetings in Moseley Hall, which will be set up with plenty of chairs and “coffee hour” goodies in the back. We expect that the February 10 forum after the 9 o'clock will continue past the start of the 11:15 Mass; so if you are usually an 11 o'clocker, and you can only come on February 10, we recommend that you attend the 9 o'clock Mass that week. Members of the Search Committee will be present in addition to the moderators at both forums. The Wardens also plan to attend both sessions.
